## Covid 19 School Operations Plan



### Mitigation Strategies

- Hand sanitizing stations and frequent handwashing
- Physical distancing of 3 feet or more
- On-Site covid screening and testing
- School sponsored vaccination clinics for students, faculty and staff
- Rigorous and thorough daily cleaning and disinfection of schools and buses
- Masking required on school buses
- Masking will be optional for students and staff

### Contact Tracing/Quarantine Guidelines

- Non-masked students/staff inside 6 feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes need to quarantine
- Students/staff who correctly and consistently wear a mask will only quarantine if experiencing symptoms
- Students/staff with a positive Covid case will not be required quarantine for the next 90 days unless showing symptoms
- Quarantine period is 10 days without testing if individual is symptom free
- Quarantine period is 7 days if the individual is symptom free and receives a negative COVID-19 test 5 days or later after the last date of exposure to the case
- Fully vaccinated individuals do not need to quarantine unless experiencing symptoms
- Test to Stay will be allowed for staff only

\*The superintendent and/or designee shall have the authority to utilize 10 NTI days and up to 20 remote learning days as defined in SB1.

\*The superintendent and/or designee shall have the authority to modify this plan as needed upon collaboration with the board of education.
